NOTICE OF RACE

Rules:

- This event will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, as amended by Appendix E for RC sailing, prescriptions of US Sailing, the RC Laser class rules, the RC Laser Winter Racing Sailing Instructions and further instructions as announced by the PRO/Race Committee during the event.
- Changes to the racing rules or class rules are noted in the specific instructions where they apply.
- Each competitor is obligated to serve as Race Committee for at least two sequential heats throughout each race day. The competitors are responsible for running their heats in accordance to these NORs and the Sailing Instructions.
- The Race Committee is not the PRO and is subject to the direction of the PRO.

Eligibility: This series is open to RC Laser Class boats only.

Schedule:

- 2019: January 13th, January 20th, January 27th, February 3rd, February 10th, February 17th, February 24th, March 3rd, March 10th, March 24th, March 31st, April 7th
- On-site Registration 9:00AM – 9:30AM
- Skippers meetings begin at 9:30AM, races begin at **10:00AM sharp**. No race will start after **12:30PM**

Location: Racing will be held at the Raritan Yacht Club, 160 Water Street, Perth Amboy, NJ

Entry: Participation in the series is \$5 per boat per day either payable in cash or via club charge. Non-RYC members are welcome to participate but must contact one of the RYC RC Laser Fleet Captains in advance.

Sailing Instructions: Sailing instructions will be made available on the RC Laser Fleet page on the Raritan Yacht Club website at:

Racing format: The race committee will determine the number of races for each day after considering weather, course and equipment conditions. There will be no more than 10 races a day.

Scoring: The series will be scored in accordance with the High Point Percentage Scoring system. Scores from all races will be counted - no scores will be excluded. **This replaces rule A4.**

Prizes: Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers of the series. To qualify for inclusion in the final series results a boat shall compete in at least 65 percent of the races completed.

Measurements: A boat and her equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules and sailing instructions.
