Dear Winter Storers,

Haulout Day is Saturday, October 27, 2018. High tide is approx. 10:15 am. **Everyone hauling a boat must be at the yard by 7:30am.** We will begin to prepare the yard between 7:30-8:30am, followed by a *mandatory attendance safety meeting* in the *Grill Room at 8:30 am.* We will begin hauling boats at 9:00 am. Everyone must be in attendance from 7:30 am until all boats are hauled **and the yard is in order.** In the unlikely event we do not finish on Saturday, you must be prepared to return to the yard on Sunday, even if your boat was hauled on Saturday. If all goes as planned, we should be done by 1:30 pm on Saturday. ***Owners with boats on trailers are responsible to assure everything is in good shape to be moved, (tire pressure, etc) the boats need to be out of the yard either Friday afternoon or by 7:00 am Saturday, you should be there to assist in the move. Some boats/trailers do not need to move, those boats will be marked with a strip of grey duck tape. I do plan to move most boats out of the yard on Friday, if you can come to help Friday afternoon I will not refuse.**

Rules:

1. You are responsible for working safely.
2. No Alcohol may be consumed until the haulout is finished.
3. It is **highly recommended** that you have a working handheld VHF radio with you at all times you are on your boat.
4. Everyone will have specific crew assignments.
5. Anyone sending a substitute to work for them must get approval of this with the Chairman of the Launch (Ann Myer) beforehand.
6. Boats which are stored in the yard on trailers must be removed by 7:00 am. Each owner is individually responsible for this. **Trailer crew be at club by 7:00 am to get trailers out.**
7. Straps crew, hooking and unhooking on boats, must wear hardhats.
8. Straps on all boats must be tied fore and aft, close to the gunwale.
9. No boats will be hauled next winter that are not placed on stands or which are not secured with chains.
10. You will need 4 long (approx. 25 ft) dock lines secured to your boat (bow & stern, port/starboard) before we can haul it.
11. **You are responsible to provide suitable keel blocking material for your boat. Along with chain to secure your stands.**
12. The Board of Governors and Flag officers have indicated that failure to abide by the launch and haul out rules will result in the suspension of storage privileges for one year.
13. **You must complete the Winter Storage Contract and provide us with a copy of your insurance certificate and the declaration page showing RYC is additionally insured. Copy of the contract is attached. Bring all this on Saturday if you have not already turned in to the club.**

Please note: The following are on the Bottoms Crew (pressure washing): Nancy Scheraga and John Russell. This can be a dirty and wet task, old foulies, boots and plastic gloves are recommended also bring a scraper. (sorry guys, this job goes to the Newbies!)

*Crew Boss

- Please wear old clothes and **bring work gloves.**
- When you arrive at 7:30am (or earlier) organize and get your stands together. Those being placed on the South side of the yard please carry your stands over to the south side. Placement sheets will be available.
- If your boat is one of the first 3 boats, go get it and bring it to the dock. Anyone who is a long way out in the fleet bring your boat in closer and pick up an open mooring.
- If you have engine problems or expect to, be sure you notify the launch drivers. Go out earlier to be sure you can get the boat in timely.
- **Don't forget to bring chain for your boat stands**
- **Grease your boat stands**
- Once your boat is placed the chain **must** be put on by the owner immediately following. (will not be powerwashed w/o chain on!)
- Bring the wood blocking for your keel. Do not assume there is wood in the yard for you.
- Please remember we are not done until all boats are hauled, the Opti Float is out and all the trailered boats are put back in the yard.

Thank you all for all your help. We accomplish a lot on haul out and launch and it is nice to all work together. Thank you in advance for making this a wonderful day! Be Safe!!
