## NOTICE OF RACE

## **Rules:**

- This event will be governed by The Racing Rules of Sailing for 2017-2020, as amended by Appendix E for RC sailing, prescriptions of US Sailing, the RC Laser class rules, the RC Laser Summer Racing Sailing Instructions and further instructions as announced by the PRO/Race Committee during the event.
- Changes to the racing rules or class rules are noted in the specific instructions where they apply.
- Each competitor is obligated to serve as Race Committee for at least two sequential races throughout each race day. The competitors are responsible for running their races in accordance to this NOR and the Sailing Instructions.
- The Race Committee is not the PRO and is subject to the direction of the PRO.

Eligibility: This series is open to RC Laser Class boats only. Anyone who has an RC Laser boat is welcome!

Schedule: Races will be held on the following dates:

July 10<sup>th</sup>July 30<sup>th</sup>August 27<sup>th</sup>October 1<sup>st</sup>

- In the event a race day is canceled, up to one canceled race days can be rescheduled. Make up date is October 8<sup>th</sup>.
- On-site Registration 6:00 PM 6:30 PM; Racing begins at 6:30 PM. No race will start after 8:30 PM

Location: Racing will be held at the Raritan Yacht Club, 160 Water Street, Perth Amboy, NJ

**Entry**: Participation in the series is \$20 per skipper either payable in cash or via club charge. Non-RYC members are welcome to participate and must contact the series organizer in advance.

**Racing format**: The PRO will determine the number of races for each day after considering weather, course, remaining daylight and equipment conditions. There will be no more than 10 races a day.

**Scoring:** The series will be scored in accordance with the High Point Percentage Scoring system. Scores from all races will be counted - no scores will be excluded. **This replaces rule A4.** 

**Prizes:** Prizes will be awarded to the top 3 finishers of the series. To qualify for inclusion in the final series results, a skipper shall compete in at least 45% of the races completed.

**Measurements:** A boat and her equipment may be inspected at any time for compliance with class rules and sailing instructions.
