1 Sailing Instructions

- 1.1 This event shall be governed by the rules as defined in RYC's General Sailing Instructions unless altered in these NORs.
- 1.2 The RYC Sailing instructions are located at <http://www.ryc.org>>Race.

2 Rules

- 2.1 Crew limit of 2, no additional people or otherwise, allowed.

3 Communications

- On the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make courtesy broadcast to competitors on VHF radio. The channel is stated in the Sis.
- 3.1 While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.

4 Eligible Entries

- 4.1 Class 1 - PHRF A
- 4.2 All boats interested in racing in the PHRF A fleet must preregister no later than the Wednesday prior to the first race. Otherwise, there will only be a PHRF B start for the entirety of the series.

5 Fees

5.1 Double-Hand Series - \$50

5.2 This event is included in the *Weekend Pass*.

6 Schedule of Races

6.1 Race 1

- May 25th
 - Class 1 - First Gun @ 15:00

6.2 Race 2

- June 22th
 - Class 1 - First Gun @ 15:00

6.3 Race 3

- July 20th
 - Class 1 - First Gun @ 15:00

6.4 Race 4

- August 24th
 - Class 1 - First Gun @ 15:00

7 Format

7.1 The majority of the races will be buoy races of 10 miles or more conditions permitting.

7.2 At the discretion of the PRO, there may be a day of Windward Leeward courses.

7.2.1 Should more than one race be sailed on a given day, the results will be rolled up to an overall score for that day, and count as one race in the series scoring.

8 Starts

8.1 The start shall be as prescribed by Section 8 of the SIs.

8.2 Harbor start will be 1 hour prior to the first gun.

9 Series Scoring

9.1 If four or more races are completed in the series there shall be one throw out.
