- 2.1 PHRF-MA Crew Limitations: Are waived for this race.
- 2.2 In the interest of increasing participation, a yacht that does not have a PHRF-MA certificate, may be assigned a handicap value for this event only. It is assumed the competitor will register the yacht with PHRF before entering any additional RYC race events.

3 Communications

3.1 On the water, the Race Committee (RC) may make courtesy broadcast to competitors on VHF radio. The channel is stated in the Sis.

3.2 While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communications that is not available to all boats.
